Quality in Gastrointestinal Endoscopy

Gastrointestinal endoscopy has become of paramount importance for diagnosing, treating and preventing diseases of the digestive tract. Endoscopy procedures are invasive and have the potential to cause harm to the patient, so every time an endoscopy is indicated, the benefits obtained from it must outweigh the risks of the procedure.

A high-quality endoscopy is an examination in which patients receive an indicated procedure, correct and relevant diagnoses are recognized or excluded, any therapy provided is appropriate, and all steps to minimise risk have been taken.

The quality of endoscopy varies and we must be sure we are providing the highest possible standard of care.

We want to focus on how to measure and optimise best care, discussing quality indicators in upper and lower GI procedures, ERCP and EUS. How can we achieve and measure endoscopy competence? Are guidelines and certification a good way to go?

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
